Scholarship Criteria/Information

To be eligible to apply for the scholarship applicant must attain and submit the following:

- Applicant must be a current senior at Lafayette High School, Wildwood, Mo. with a minimum 3.5 GPA, a US citizen and committed to attending college the fall semester following graduation. *(Attach official transcript and name of the college you plan to attend.)*
- Applicant must be a member of Young Life or a religious organization. *(Attach the name of the organization and the group leader's name and contact information.)*
- Attach a typed, double spaced personal essay of at least 500 and no more than 750 words, detailing how you "Make It Count" and will pass on Andrew's legacy.
- Applications must be submitted to Lafayette guidance counselor's office no later than February 20th of the applicant's senior year.
- The Andrew D Keithley Make It Count scholarship association will select the recipient of the scholarship.
- The recipient will be notified during the month of March of the applicant's senior year. The award will be presented at the Lafayette High School Senior Awards night.
- One scholarship will be awarded annually and is not renewable.
