Scholarship Criteria/Information

To be eligible to apply for the scholarship applicant must attain and submit the following:

- Attach official transcript
- Please name the University, College, Vocational School or Technical School you plan to attend
- Applicant must be a current senior at Lafayette High School, Wildwood, Mo. with a minimum 3.5 GPA, a US citizen and committed to attending University, College, Vocational School or Technical School in the fall semester following graduation.
- Applicant must be a member of a fellowship organization.
(Attach the name of the organization and the group leader's name and contact information.)
- Attach a Personal Essay detailing how you "Make It Count" and will pass on Andrew's legacy.
(Typed, double-spaced, at least 500 and no more than 750 words.)
- Applications may be emailed to admin@adkmic.org or submitted to Lafayette guidance counselor's office no later than February 20th of the applicant's senior year.
- The Andrew D Keithley Make It Count scholarship association will select the recipient of the scholarship.
- The recipient will be notified during the month of March of the applicant's senior year. The award will be presented at the Lafayette High School Senior Awards night.
- One scholarship will be awarded annually and is not renewable.
